

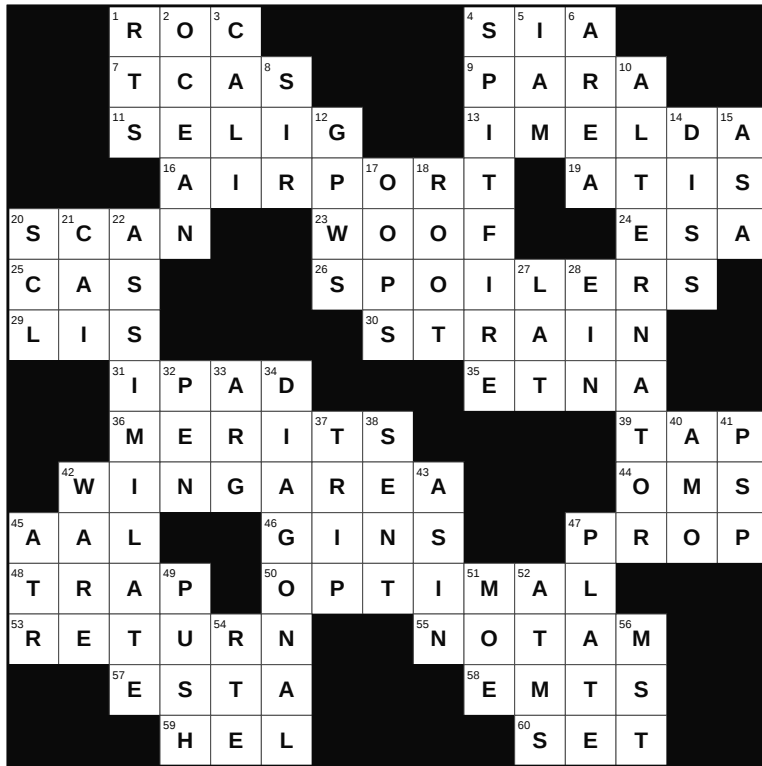

THIS DAY IN AVIATION

1967

August 26, 1967

On August 26, 1967, Major George Everette Day, a U.S. Air Force Forward Air Controller Pilot flying an F-100, was forced to eject over North Vietnam after his aircraft was hit by ground fire. Suffering a broken right arm and a badly sprained left knee, he was immediately captured by hostile forces. Taken to a prison camp, Day endured interrogation and severe torture, yet his personal bravery in the face of deadly enemy pressure proved significant in saving the lives of fellow aviators still flying against the enemy.

After causing guards to relax their vigilance, Day escaped into the jungle, trekking southward toward South Vietnam. Surviving on berries and uncooked frogs, he evaded patrols and reached the Ben Hai River. Using a bamboo log float, he swam across into the demilitarized zone. Delirious and losing direction, he wandered aimlessly for days. After unsuccessful attempts to signal U.S. aircraft, he was ambushed and recaptured by the Viet Cong, sustaining gunshot wounds to his left hand and thigh before being returned to prison.
